General Description: Challenge course installers are responsible for installing, repairing, and inspecting facility based-challenge course structures and elements. Installers work as members of a close-knit team fulfilling a variety of tasks. Typical projects include installation and maintenance of high/low challenge courses, climbing walls and towers, and zip line/canopy tours. The nature of the position requires frequent travel to various locations throughout the USA, primarily in the Northeast. Projects are scheduled year-round both indoors and outdoors. At times, work is performed in inclement or extreme weather and sometimes in challenging locations and environments.

- Ability to lift and carry 75+ pounds
- Be able to climb ladders and work comfortably at height
- Possess good communication skills
